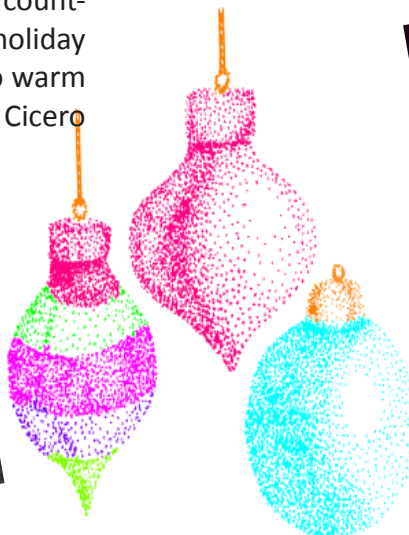
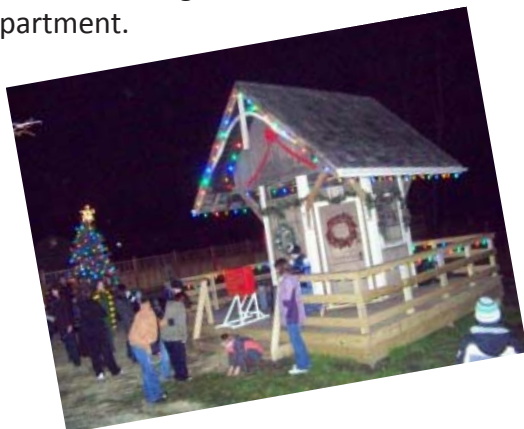

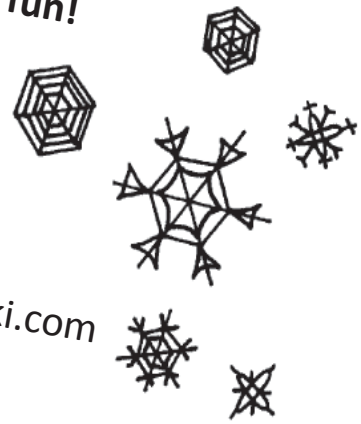

This is a class for any person, of any age (3 and up) interested in learning how to skate. Adults welcome, as well as those interested in hockey.

Intro to Synchro:

For this class, skaters must have completed at least a Basic 5 class in order to participate. Skaters will become members of the beginner Synchronized skating team "The Icicles" and compete in local competitions. This program will teach skaters how to time their moves to music and work together to create synchronized movement on the ice. It's a great way to work and fall in love with being part of a team!

Bridge Program:

This is an on-circuit training program which will focus on jumps, spins, moves in the field, ice dance, artistry in motion and power skating. Skaters will also have a 15 minute off-ice training afterwards. Participants must be in Basic 4 or higher to join.

RECREATIONAL GYMNASTICS

Ages 4 and up

This is an exciting program to work on progressions and beginner gymnastics skills on vault, bars, beam, floor, and trampoline/tumble trak for both boys and girls. Students will develop strength, flexibility, and coordination while learning new gymnastics skills. As they learn new skills, gymnastics will be fun and exciting along with the added benefit of increased self-esteem.

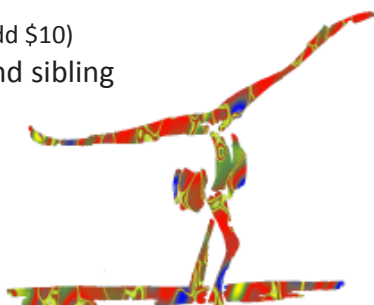

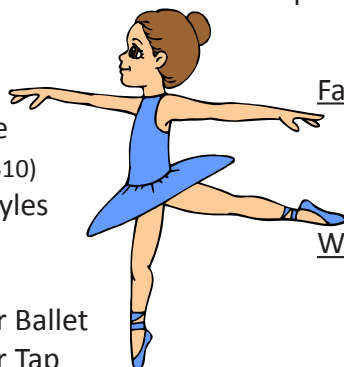


YOUTH PROGRAMS!
